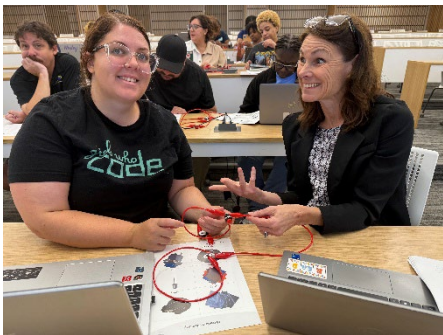




YES-Engineering is Elementary (EiE) for Grades 4-5

The Tulane University Center for K-12 Education will offer 2 teacher professional training sessions in **YES - Engineering is Elementary (EiE)** curriculum for grades 4-5 on **Saturday, August 16, 2025**.
