## Learning Sessions

**Sixteen Weeks. Big Ideas.  
Hands-On Fun.**

Students will jump into 16 weeks of afterschool fun with two sessions a week from 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.

They'll explore civic and intellectual virtues like gratitude, leadership, community awareness, critical thinking, service, neighborliness, and confidence. Small groups and hands-on activities keep things lively, and every session ends with check-ins and reflection time to help ideas stick.
